To ensure that you have the best result possible after treatment for your veins it is important to follow the instructions below:

Wear compression stockings day and night for 7 days continuously. This means that you can NOT remove stocking for washing etc.

Continue wearing compression stockings each day for a further 1 to 2 weeks – remove the stockings overnight.

If you experience discomfort in the area of the treated vein, consider taking oral ibuprofen 400mg up to three times daily for 3 to 5 days. *Please ensure that this is suitable for you and does not interact with any other medication you are taking, check with your General Practitioner if you are unsure.*

Normal activity, and usually return to work can be undertaken immediately after the treatment.

Aim to walk between 10,000 and 12,000 steps a day (about 1.5 - 2.0 miles), over the course of each day. Jogging, running, and cycling can recommence after week one, as long as the stockings remain in place.

Please avoid the following activities for the first 4 weeks after treatment:

- heavy lifting, using weights in the gym this increases pressure on the veins and can cause the veins to reopen.
- avoid hot showers/baths, saunas and steam rooms veins naturally relax and open in response to heat.
